Re: #2 Pulaski St, drainage pipe

I recently met with Mike Papierz concerning his proposed storm pipe connection to a Village drainage structure in front of his residence at 2 Pulaski St. This storm pipe would be a private project.

The drainage area tributary to his backyard includes just about all backyards bounded by Pulaski, Young, Fairway and Burrstone. We had a discussion with his father several years ago concerning the volume of surface water from that area onto his parcel, but no action was taken.

His current, original scope was the construction of a smaller diameter underdrain pipe. In our opinion, the problem is the volume of surface runoff, which would not be best addressed by an underdrain. While the Village would have minimal jurisdiction over what this pipe on private property, we recommended:

- A drop inlet drainage structure be placed in a low spot in his backyard with a grate and some grading to collect that surface runoff;
- A 12" pipe be installed to convey that runoff to the Village drainage structure next to his driveway, together with tees and lateral pipes to the 4 roof leaders on the residences;
- A second small diameter (4") underdrain should be placed to drain groundwater from behind the driveway's retaining wall;
- Grading a swale in his lawn to direct remaining surface water to the Village drainage structure's inlet.

Regarding the connection(s) to the Village drainage structure, we take no exception. An opening can be made in the wall for the new pipe(s). Although the patched opening doesn't need to be watertight, it must be sufficient to restrict the passage of soil.
