****IMPORTANT**-Parents must completely read the following rules and review them with your child/children. Not obeying the rules could result in loss of program privileges for the remainder of the summer at the discretion of the Director, Attendants and Commissioners.**

The summer program will be held at the school and will have two sessions on non-field trip days, running from 9:00-11:45 and 12:15-3:00. The sessions will be divided into age groups this year. Students going into Grades 1-3 will attend the morning session from 9:00-11:45. Students going into Grades 4-6 will attend the afternoon session from 12:15-3:00.

On the days with scheduled Field Trips, all age groups will be eligible to attend for the entire day. The tentative weekly plan is to have full-day field trips on Mondays and Fridays, smaller trips to Marquee Cinemas and then somewhere local on Wednesdays, and full camp days on Tuesdays and Thursdays.

Registrations and Medical Release forms must be submitted to the Village Clerk before June 30th. They will be available at the school or clerk's office after 6/15. Please review the program rules with your children when you register them. The program will begin on July 6th and run through August 19th. Children going into grades 1-6 that meet at least one of the following criteria can participate.

- 1) Attend New York Mills Elementary School
- 2) Live in the Village of New York Mills
- 3) Live in the Village of Yorkville

Program Rules

1. Please **arrive to pick up children** approximately **15 minutes prior** to the end of their session. Staff leaves promptly at 3 PM. **There will not be supervision for your child after 3 PM if you are late.**
2. All children attending the program are expected to behave in a respectful manner. **Any inappropriate conduct can result in the temporary or permanent suspension** from the program. All decisions regarding behavior are made at the discretion of the commissioners, director, and/or attendants.
3. Children must be going into grades 1 – 6 to attend.
