At the August 8<sup>th</sup> Board meeting, I would like to report on the following items:

A Mill #3 storm sewer improvements:

At the July meeting, mapping was distributed of the storm sewer system on the east side of Mill #3. Although no format easements have been located, it is our opinion the storm system is a Village pipe.

We have followed up with field investigations. Four of the drainage structures need remedial work. A 5<sup>th</sup> structure on Prospect St needs to have its cover raised to grade. CCTV inspection was used to attempt to locate a 6<sup>th</sup> buried structure but DPW has determined it is very deep.

Sketches of proposed remedial work are being prepared. We will solicit quotes from Contractors for Board consideration at the next meeting.
