Fabbio broke a window in the vehicle and promptly removed the man who had a pulse but was not breathing. He administered aid, the man began breathing and the patient was turned over to UFD paramedics.

October is Fire Prevention Month - we've been very active presenting fire safety information at Apple Tree Pre School, Harts Hill Elementary, Home Depot, New Harford Square Apartments and NYM Senior Center. More sessions are scheduled at Country Club Courts Apartments, Lowes, NYM School and Mastrovito Hyundai.

Radios - We still need to purchase digital radios. Oneida County recently decommissioned analog radios on Oct 6 which means the firefighters/EMTs who currently carry those radios and the vehicles that only have analog mobile radios will not be able to contact Fire Control.

Holmatro tool – the cutter tool was damaged at a recent training session. We will be contacting the vendor concerning repairs.

Access system – the key fob access network failed last week and locked us out of the firehouse during an alarm. We need to work with the vendor to come up with a solution to avoid a recurrence.
